

### Recent changes to A-level Curriculum

Fourth content-based A-level subject to be dropped from university admission score



- General Paper will become a compulsory subject.
- Knowledge and Inquiry will be offered only as a contrasting subject.
- Project work will be graded on a Pass or Fail basis. Students will need to pass it to be eligible for admission to Autonomous Universities.
- Progressive removal of Mid-year exams for JCs and MI from year 2024.





### **Aptitude Based Admissions / EAE**

When Ms Hemavarshnee Saravanan was in Secondary 4, she started a hair accessories business with a friend. It sealed her decision to apply to a polytechnic via the early admissions exercise purpose MEE ANN POLYTECHNIC

Hemavarshnee Saravanan was in Secondary 4, she started a hair accessories business with a friend to sell scrunchies in school-approved colours.

"Students want to look as cute as possible, but it was hard to do that with school rules. So we decided to sell white or green hair ties to give students more options instead of just using black rubber bands," says the former St Margaret's Secondary student.

According to the Ministry of Education, applications and admissions via the polytechnic EAE have remained relatively consistent over the past three years. About 13,500 students applied for the polytechnic EAE in 2023 for admission in 2024, and 5,500 received an offer.

Miss Jolene Chong, 20, graduated in May with a diploma in applied AI and analytics from Nanyang Polytechnic (NYP). She shared during the EAE interview that she was involved in freelance work during her secondary school days, developing websites from scratch for clients from a job portal.

She topped her diploma programme with a 4.0 GPA and will be studying computer science at the National University of Singapore.

### What is the Early Admissions Exercise or EAE?

- Do not have to compete for admission to Post-Sec Educational Institutions (PSEIs) based on their academic results compared to everyone else.
- Secure a place in a competitive course.
- Have relevant aptitude and interests to support their EAE application.
- Clear about the course they wish to pursue.

### Why EAE?

- Secure a place in a competitive POLY course.
- The students who receive conditional offers would still need to meet the two criteria to have a confirmed course placement.
  - Criteria: 1. Min. Entry Requirements (MERs)
    - 2. Subject pre-requisites.

### What to prepare?

#### **General application**


- 1. Write Up Personal, Talent and Achievement.
- 2. Pre-interview Aptitude test.
- 3. Pre-interview survey. Auditions, Trials.
- 4. Interview Individual / Group, Online or Onsite.
- 5. Portfolio.
