

ITE 3 Year Higher Nitec

- From 2026, all ITE courses will transition to 3 Year Higher Nitec programmes
 - School of Health Sciences
 - School of Business and Services
 - School of Design and Media
 - School of Electronics & Info-Comm Technology
 - School of Engineering
- Eligibility Best 4 subjects including pre-requisite subjects and bonus points.
- 3-year Higher NITEC offers a streamlined curriculum in Yr 1 before specialization. Internship attachment in Yr 2 & 3.

More pathways to polys for ITE students from 2027



UPDATED JUL 21, 2023, 11-22 PM SGT +

More Institute of Technical Education (ITE) students will be given the chance to move on to polytechnics from academic year 2027, as part of efforts to expand pathways and choices for students.

Those pursuing a Higher Nitec qualification at ITE will be guaranteed admission to a polytechnic course related to their Higher Nitec course, if they attain a grade point average (GPA) of 3.5 or above.

Progression to Polytechnic

- From 2027, Higher Nitec students who meet a Grade
 Point Average (GPA) of 3.5 will be guaranteed admission to a polytechnic course mapped to their Higher Nitec course
- From 2028, DPP will cease.




GPA for mapped and not mapped poly courses



ITE graduates who excel in their course of study may apply for progression* to a higher level



ITE Traineeship

Traineeship which spans from 1 to 2 years, is an apprenticeship programme designed for fresh secondary school leavers to upskill as they pursue a Nitec qualification. ITE trainees* are employees sponsored by the Approved Training Centre (ATC) who learn both on-the-job (OJT) and off-the-job (theory and practical lessons) at the sponsoring company.

- N-Level or O-Level graduates can gain work experience at an organisation accredited by ITE at an Approved Training Centre (ATC).
- Trainees are full-time employees who will receive salaries, CPF contributions and employment in accordance with MOM guidelines.

4-Year Higher Nitec Courses with Enhanced Foundation Programme and 3-Year Nitec Course with Enhanced Nitec Foundation Programme

ITE had introduced the **4-year** *Higher Nitec* Course with Enhanced Foundation Programme and **3-year** *Nitec* Course with Enhanced *Nitec* **Foundation** Programme for Singaporean/Singapore Permanent Resident Normal (Technical) holders with '0' or '1' GCE 'N' Level pass. The 4-year *Higher Nitec* Course with Enhanced Foundation Programme begins with a Preparatory Year that will prepare students for Year 1 of the *Higher Nitec* course. Students who opt for the 3-Year *Nitec* course with Enhanced *Nitec* Foundation Programme will undergo two years of foundation training for a *Nitec* course before progressing on to the final year. In addition to the hands-on training, both programmes will strengthen students' literacy and numeracy skills and improve their self-confidence and motivation. This will prepare them for lifelong learning and success.



What is Early Admissions Exercise (EAE)?

- For students who have strong aptitude and interest in specific fields of study.
- Secure a place in a competitive ITE course.
- Students who have applied will be assessed through different modes e.g. Interviews.
 - EAE Application in May.
 - ITE Selection and Interview in June
 - EAE Course acceptance in August.



Why EAE?

- Secure a place in a competitive ITE course.
- The students who receive conditional offers would still need to meet the two criteria to have a confirmed course placement.
 - Criteria: 1. Min. Entry Requirements (MERs)
 - 2. Subject pre-requisites.

Processing ITE outcomes

If you ACCEPT EAE Conditional Offer,

Course Cut-off Points do **NOT** apply to you

Once you meet MER, EAE Conditional Offer is automatically confirmed.
